On all trips accommodation is on a twin share basis. It might be possible for the winner to pay a supplement to book single rooms.

Confirmation of the winner's chosen holiday dates is subject to availability.

To go on a Traidcraft Meet the People Tour, if you are under 18 you must be accompanied by a fully-paying adult.

Flights will be economy class, leaving from a UK airport. Skedaddle will help and advise the booking of appropriate flights in consultation with the winner. Shared Interest Foundation will fund flights up to a maximum of £1,100. In line with environmental policy, Shared Interest Foundation will carbon-offset the flights.

Once the winner has returned from the holiday, he or she will be required to write at least one blog post describing their experience and their impressions from meeting the producers. The blog may be used on Shared Interest or Skedaddle websites and print publications.

You must arrange your own travel insurance. Skedaddle offers competitive insurance, details of which will be provided to the holiday winner.

Passport, visa and vaccination fees, travel to and from the UK departure airport, and the costs of meals, drinks and activities not specified in the itinerary in the Skedaddle Tour Dossier must be met by the winner.
